FDOT Official Highway Mileage Viewer

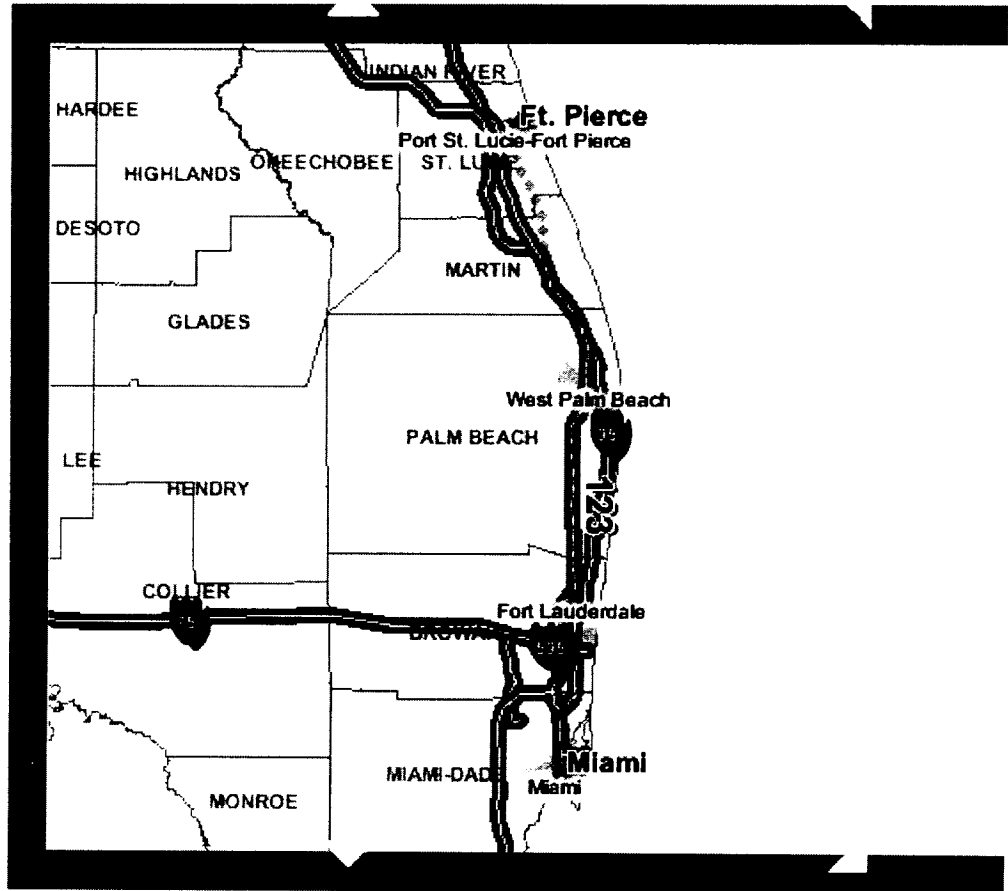

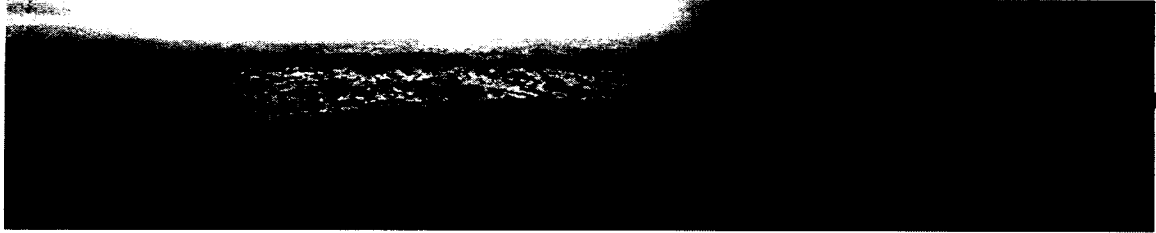

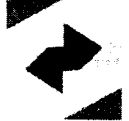
